

Girls' School Sacramento Mission Statement:

The mission of Girls' School Sacramento is to develop well-rounded, self-reliant, socially concerned, competitive young women. This will be accomplished in a climate of safety, community, and respect, using a rigorous academic curriculum dedicated to the unique needs and learning styles of girls.

- Girls' School Sacramento teaches the rigorous Core Knowledge curriculum and specific state standards. Our instructional program validates each girl and allows girls to achieve at their own level. There are no shortcuts to excellence. This challenging curriculum, taught in a small school environment by caring, credentialed teachers, nurtures girls' self-confidence and optimism and inspires them to achieve.
- GSS utilizes counseling programs (and employs a licensed therapist consultant) which focus on girls' issues including "Queen Bee" behaviors (anti-bullying program), eating disorder education and prevention, self-esteem and self-worth issues, health education, leadership, independence and self-sufficiency training, and high school preparation.
- GSS addresses itself to the question of how girls learn best. We train our teaching, support, and administrative staff in the learning styles of girls, and we specifically manipulate and design curricular components to fit our students.
- Girls thrive on connections between people and disciplines (areas of learning). At GSS we know your daughter, and we are educating the WHOLE girl.
- GSS is a place where girls don't have to impress or compete with anyone but themselves. Here, girls grow to value their voices, develop empathy (through our required community service program and world view curriculum), and set and reach personal goals.
- GSS is an inclusive community where diversity is a component of excellence, and all members of the community are respected.
- Girls need time to connect- with family, friends, and the community- as well as self. Our extended school day, school year, and intersession allow for specific activities to meet these needs.
- Girls' School Sacramento is a school for girls only. Faculty and administration EXPECT girls to succeed.
